CALL TO ORDER:

The Town Council Budget Work Session was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor Greer.

Mr. Duer recommended a \$1.00 rate increase per trash can, but no increase on water or sewer. He said that employee raises should remain at 1.5% in July and \$500 or 1%, whichever is higher, at their anniversary date. Councilman Sturgis said he feels that a 5% increase would help offset the rise in the cost of living. He recommended 4% in July and \$500 or 1% at their anniversary date.


Mr. Duer noted that Chief DiMartino has requested more police training for all the officers.

They discussed a pay increase for the Council of \$900 per Councilman for the year.

Mr. Duer said that the budget does not reflect any of the grant or loan funds, but a budget amendment can be done if necessary.

Mr. Duer noted that there may be approximately \$50,000 reserve to be added to the Capital Improvement Fund.
