OPEN PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Greer opened the Public Hearing with the majority in attendance reciting the pledge of allegiance.

PUBLIC HEARING – CDBG FUNDING:

OVERVIEW BY MR. DUKES (SLIDESHOW):


Mr. Dukes explained that this is the second of two Public Hearings required by the DHCD as a part of the process to obtain the \$500,000 grant. This grant will help fund the cost of the construction of the new wells, the water filtration plant and the force main. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$1,800,000. The Department of Health and Office of Drinking Water has offered a loan fund in the amount of \$813,000, principal forgiveness is \$550,000 and the grant is \$500,000. Mr. Dukes noted that we are working with our attorney to acquire the property needed for the additional drain fields. The completion date is estimated for spring of 2018.

Donald E. Kellam, Jr. asked if we would need a second water operator. Mr. Duer noted that we will most likely need a second operator.
